NAVIGATING THE SUSPENSION PROCESS

- Your courses for next semester will be purged by Records after grades are released.
- To APPEAL your academic suspension, visit the <u>Records</u> website for details and due dates. Appeals without documentation will be denied.
- Financial aid or scholarship questions? Contact the <u>Financial Aid</u> <u>Office.</u>
- Living in university housing? Reach out to the <u>housing office</u> for check-out procedures.

APPEAL YOUR SUSPENSION

• Who reviews an academic suspension appeal? The AARC does not approve or deny appeals. Appeals are reviewed by a committee and are only accepted with documented extenuating circumstances. In other words, your appeal will not

• Suspended Fall 2024? You will be eligible to re-admit to TSU in Fall 2025, unless you successfully appeal to return next semester. If you are sitting out, you may not enroll at any other institution while away.

be reviewed by the committee if you do not have documented evidence to support the appeal.

Is SAP different from a suspension appeal? Yes.
SAP is strictly financial.
Appeals for academic suspension are separate from the financial aid appeal process.
