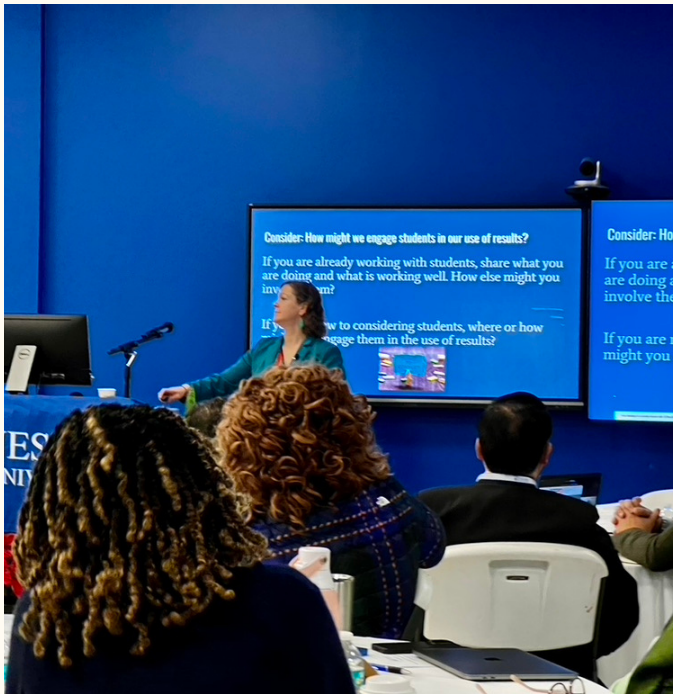
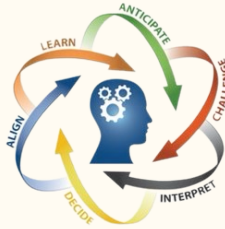


# Assessment Newsletter
