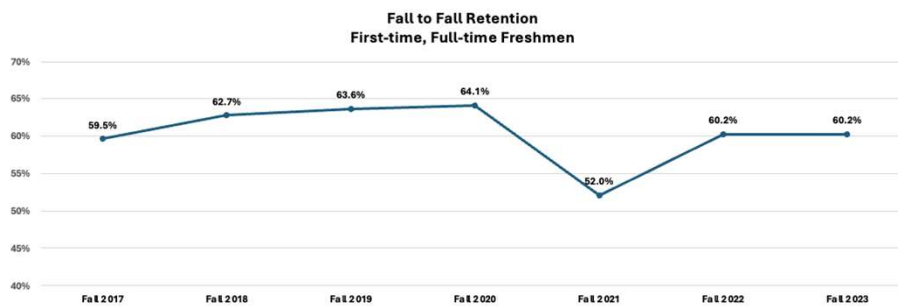


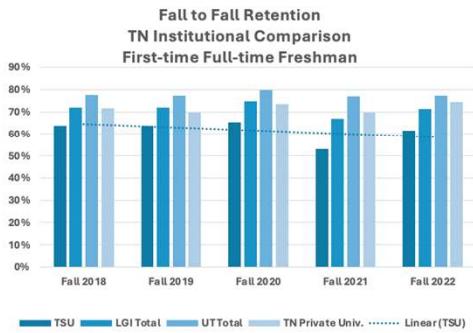

Overall Retention Rate



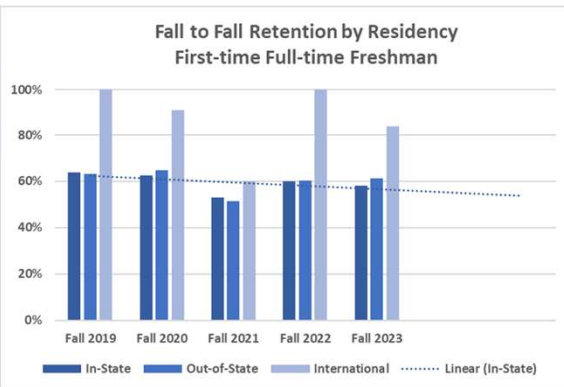

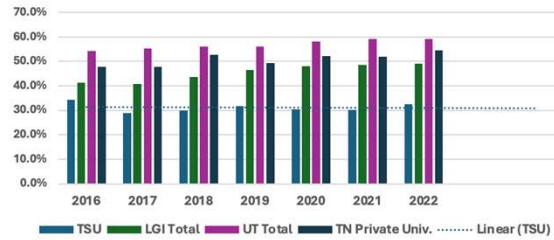

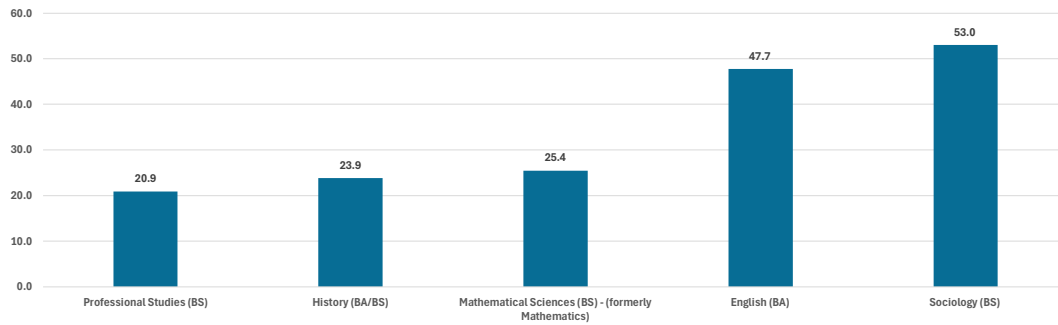

Major Program Enrollment Summary – Bachelor's Degrees

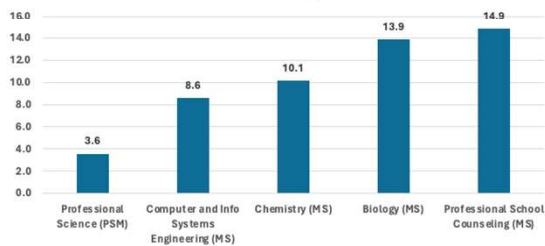
Enrollment by Major Program (Summary)

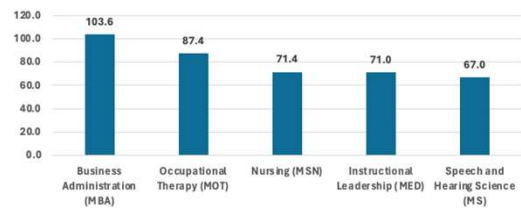

Master's Programs

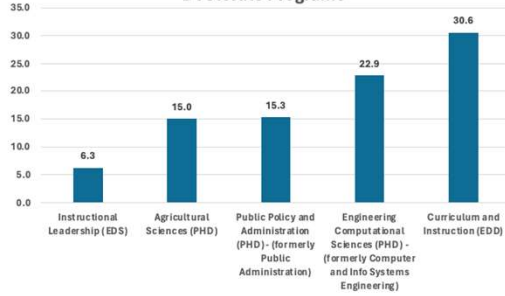


Enrollment by Major Program (Summary) Highest

Master's Programs

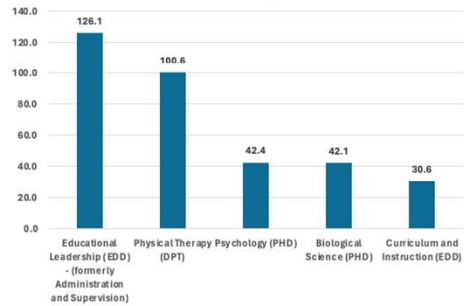


Major Program Enrollment Summary – Doctorate Degrees
