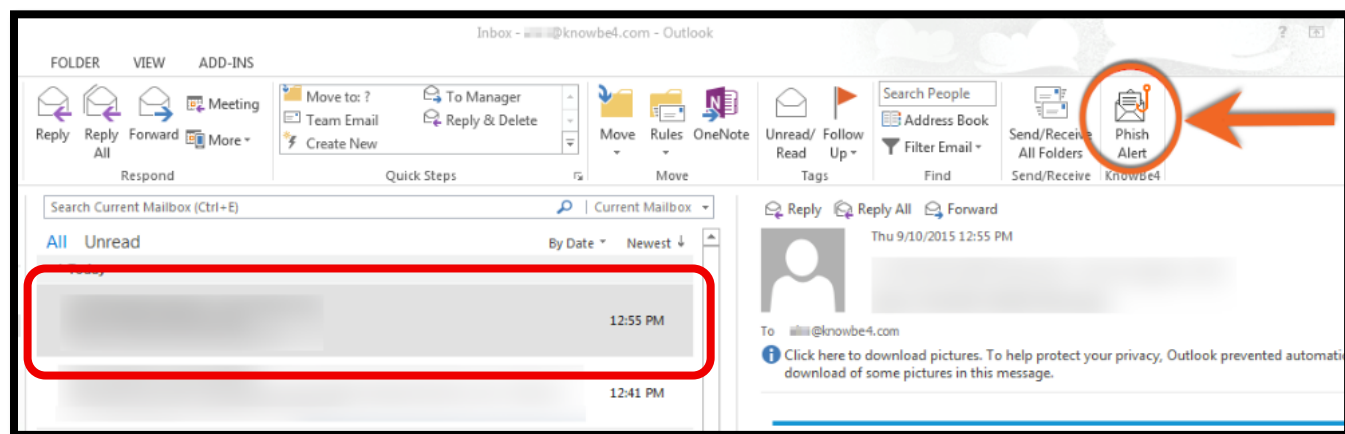


## How to use Phish Alert Button (PAB)

If you receive phishing, suspicious, or unwanted emails, you can utilize the **Phish Alert Button (PAB)**. This feature will automatically delete the email from your inbox and report it to TSU at [otssecurity@tnstate.edu](mailto:otssecurity@tnstate.edu) to block the sender from contacting other users in the TSU community. When you report a suspicious email, our system automatically analyzes it to determine whether it is malicious. Safe messages are returned to your inbox, while dangerous ones are quarantined. This process helps protect all TSU users from similar threats.

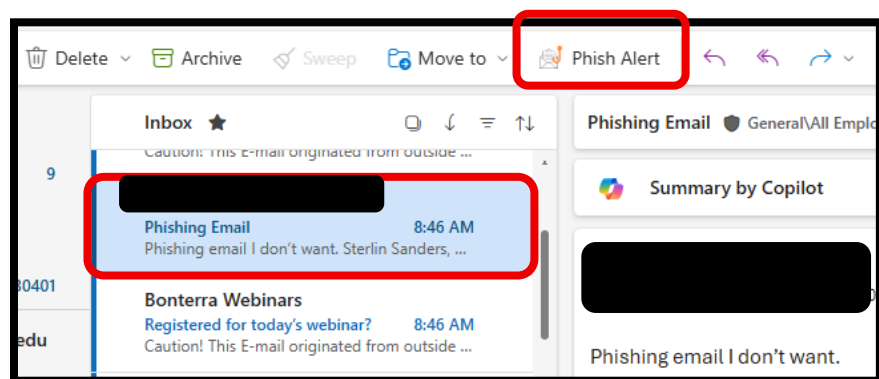
Please see the instructions below for assistance with using the Outlook application or the online O365 email account.
