

Ms. Cynthia G. Snyder, currently serves as the Associate Director for Support at the National Geospatial-intelligence Agency (NGA), Springfield, VA. She has been with NGA for 17 years and was appointed to the Defense Intelligence Senior Executive Service in September 2007. Prior to joining NGA in January 2005, Ms. Snyder served 25 years' active duty in the U.S. Air Force and retired in the grade of Colonel.

As the Associate Director for support, she is responsible for synchronizing and managing NGA Human Resources, training and education, career services, leader development, protective services, security, counterintelligence, insider threat, classification management, information and records management, and facilities and installation management activities to ensure mission success and alignment with the NGA Strategy. She is also responsible for the planning and programming of NGA's business services missions to ensure agile, efficient, and effective operations in support of the core mission areas of NGA and its Department of Defense and Foreign Partners.

Prior to assuming her current position, Ms. Snyder served as NGA's Deputy Director for Geospatial-Intelligence Mission Planning and Policy for the Analysis Plans and Business Operations Group; the Department of Navy Naval Intelligence Civilian Human Capital Officer; the Director of NGA's Human Development Strategies Office; NGA's Security and Installation Office Director of Installation Operations; the Architect of the Capitol's Director for Congressional and External Relations where she served as the Architect's and Chief Operating Officer's political strategist.

During her distinguished Air Force career, Ms. Snyder garnered extensive and diverse leadership and management experience after four commands and numerous installation and staff positions, to include serving as Deputy Base Commander in support of Iraqi Freedom. She served at the installation level, Major Command, Air Force Secretariat and on the Joint Chiefs of Staff (J-4 Logistics), where she also augmented the National Military Command Center.

Ms. Snyder holds a Bachelor of Science degree in Civil Engineering from Tennessee State University; a Master of Science Degree in Operations Management from the University of Arkansas; and a Master of Science Degree in National Resource Strategy from the National Defense University. Ms. Snyder is a FY2019 Presidential Rank Award Recipient.

She continues to support numerous church and local community activities, to include local school fund raisers to support children in her community.
