Laveil Allen, M.D., is a native Nashvillian. He completed his undergraduate studies at Tennessee State University prior to enrolling at Meharry Medical College, where he earned his medical degree with honors. Following Meharry Medical College, Dr. Allen completed a transitional intern year at Harvard, Cambridge Hospital and served as a clinical fellow at Harvard Medical School. Subsequently, he completed his residency in Diagnostic Radiology at Tulane University Hospital. In 2015, Dr. Allen joined VUMC as an Emergency Radiology faculty member while simultaneously completing his fellowship training in Musculoskeletal Radiology. In 2013, he was promoted to Assistant to Associate Professor and given the role of Executive Vice Chair.

Dr. Allen is a dually appointed faculty member in the Departments of Emergency Medicine and Radiology & Radiological Sciences at Vanderbilt University Medical Center. He currently serves as the Executive Medical Director and Division Chief of Emergency Radiology at Vanderbilt. Dr. Allen also proudly serves as the Faculty Advisor to the Meharry Medical College – Vanderbilt Student Alliance. In addition, he holds an appointment at Meharry Medical College as an adjunct professor, where he serves as the senior director for the Meharry Medical College Diagnostic Radiology Clerkship Program.
