MOVE-IN DATES & TIMES

For First-Time Freshmen in Wilson Hall:

Tuesday, August 12

- 1st, 5th, and 6th Floors: 7:00 AM – 11:00 AM
- 2nd Floor: 11:00 AM – 2:00 PM

Wednesday, August 13

- 3rd Floor: 7:00 AM – 9:00 AM
- 4th Floor: 9:00 AM – 12:00 PM

For First-Time Freshmen in All Other Residence Halls:

Wednesday, August 13

- All Floors: 8:00 AM – 1:00 PM

Note: First-year students do **not** need to schedule a move-in appointment. You may report directly to your designated check-in location at the date and time listed here.

MOVE-IN CHECKPOINT LOCATIONS

- **Wilson Hall Residents:** Report to the **Gentry Center Checkpoint**

ONLINE PRE CHECK-IN

To speed up your arrival process, please complete the **Online Pre Check-In Form** via the **myTSU Housing Portal** before move-in day. This will be available beginning August 8, 2025.

- Please be ready to **show your confirmation email** when you arrive on campus.
- Failure to complete the Pre Check-In or failure to arrive during your designated move-in time may **delay your access** to your residence hall.

ADDITIONAL NOTES

- **Students with accommodations through Disability Services:**
Email **DisabilityServices@tnstate.edu** at least **two (2) days prior** to your move-in date to request special arrangements.
- **Early Arrivals:**
Must receive official **university approval** and contact the Office of Residence Life to coordinate your move-in schedule.
