
## <u>eLearn Clips Report – April 2013</u>

## **College Algebra**


As of April 12, 2013, 70 students in Math 1110 College Algebra have viewed the video clips on eLearn. 53 of the students are in the non-enhanced courses, and 17 are in the enhanced courses. Below is a graph of the addition of new students viewing clips. There are 673 students enrolled in Math 1110.



The addition of new students is as follows: January – 5 February – 42 March – 14 April – 9

## **Pre-Calculus I**

As of April 12, 2013, 14 students in Math 1710 Pre-Calculus I have viewed the video clips on eLearn. Below is a graph of the addition of new students viewing clips. There are 173 students enrolled in Pre-calculus I.



The addition of new students is as follows: January – 2 February – 7 March – 3 April – 2

\*The large jump in numbers in February can be attributed to classroom talks given during that month. These instructional talks included data from previous years, as well as examples of clips and instructions on how to access and view them. Each professor who teaches college algebra and pre-calculus was sent an email detailing the talk and asking for a 5-minute window for us to come in. Of the 31 college algebra and 6 pre-calculus classes, 17 classrooms received the talks.
