

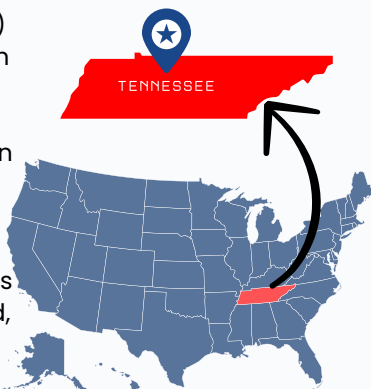

INTERNATIONAL TUITION ASSISTANCE GRANT (ITAG)

- For undergraduate students only
- Not guaranteed for every student
- Award dependent on GPA
3.25 = \$10,000 | 3.50 = \$15,000 | 3.75 = \$20,000

GRADUATE ASSISTANSHIPS

- Stipend & Tuition

- Competitive and dependent on availability

GENERAL ADMISSION REQUIREMENTS

- 2.50 cumulative weighted GPA
- 19 ACT/900 SAT (Verbal & Math scores only)

GUARANTEED ADMISSION

- 3.20 cumulative weighted GPA
- ACT or SAT Test Scores are required for all first time Freshmen under 21
- Distribution of College Preparatory courses such as: 1 Unit of US History

INTERNATIONAL UNDERGRADUATE ADMISSION

1. Admissions online application and \$25 fee.
2. Proof of language competency with one of the following:
 - a) TOEFL (61), IELTS (5), or Duolingo (71)
 - b) "C" or better in college-level English Comp I.
 - c) TSU Intensive English Level 7 or ELS Level 112 completion.
3. Official Transcripts from colleges/universities attended in the USA.
4. Official Transcripts with Grade Point Average (GPA) evaluated by a foreign educational credentialing agency, at the student's expense. Recommended agency is *Spantran*.
5. ACT/SAT test required if under age of 21.

I-20 DOCUMENTS

1. Clear color copy of passport ID.
2. Affidavit of Support and Financial Statement to cover educational and living expenses for one academic year (see chart above).
3. SEVIS transfer-in verification if currently enrolled in the USA.
4. Visa page if transferring SEVIS record.
