# A half million dollar legacy

Alumnus and sister give in honor of parents

The children of two prominent Tennessee State University alumni have donated \$250,000 in honor of their parents who attended TSU 80 years ago.

Damon Lee III, a 1967 graduate with a Business Administration degree, made the donation in the names of Damon and Rachel Lee at TSU's 2016 Scholarship Appreciation Reception on April 7. His sister, Kimberly Lee-Lamb, also contributed to the gift, which will benefit TSU's College of Business by providing scholarships to out-of-state juniors and seniors majoring in business.

The Damon and Rachel Lee Scholarship Endowment Fund was established in 1999 with a \$200,000 donation to TSU. The family donated \$50,000 to the university in 2005, and with this latest donation, their total contributions to the university exceed \$500,000.

TSU officials said the family's recent donation is among the top five given by a family in the university's history.

"We are very grateful for the contributions the Lee family has made to Tennessee State University over the years," said TSU President Glenda Glover. "This latest donation not only shows their continued commitment to TSU, but their desire to better the lives of students by helping them get a quality education to compete in the global marketplace."

Damon and Rachel Lee were college sweethearts. Damon was a founding member of TSU's Beta Omicron Chapter of Alpha Phi Alpha Fraternity, Incorporated, and graduated with honors in 1935 with a degree in History. Years later, after relocating to Los Angeles, he earned a Doctor of Chiropractic degree and license.

Rachel was a Business Education major and a member of Alpha Kappa Alpha Sorority, Incorporated. After graduating in 1936, she began a career as a business education teacher at Booker T. Washington High School in Atlanta, Georgia. She continued her teaching career in Los Angeles at the Los Angeles Unified School District.

Damon Lee III said both his parents were business advocates who believed in "people having a knowledge of business, regardless of your profession."

"The whole world revolves around business," said Lee, a retired Los Angeles-based corporate marketing executive.

Eloise Abernathy Alexis is associate vice president for institutional advancement at TSU. She said while the latest donation by the Lee family will benefit students, she believes it will also inspire other alumni to give to the university.

"Regardless of the amount, when an alum sees another alum give, they say ... 'I should do that too,'" Alexis said.



# Vintagers give more than \$250K to TSU

Tennessee State University alumni who graduated from the institution at least 40 years ago recently reported raising more than \$250,000 for student scholarships. At a luncheon in their honor before the May 6 commencement, the Vintagers made presentations totaling nearly \$256,000.

The Vintagers return to their alma mater each spring commencement and hold different functions over the weekend. Those celebrating 50-year anniversaries dress in gold caps and gowns, and join the ceremony reliving their graduation day.

"When you come back and bring a gift like this, you are securing the future of Tennessee State University," TSU President Glenda Glover told the former students at the





packed ceremony on the main campus. "Your gifts are making a tremendous difference in the lives of our students."

This year's celebration recognized the classes of 1951, 1956, 1961, 1966 and 1971.

The newest members of the group, the Class of 1976, were inducted into the organization, and pledged continued support to TSU.

On the fundraising, the Class of 1966 reported \$118,067, the most raised by any group. The Class of 1956 came in second with \$53,159, followed by the classes of 1971, \$35,426; 1976, \$32,463; 1951, \$9,495; and the Class of 1961, \$7,250.

The Vintagers are organized under the Office of Alumni Relations in the Division of Institutional Advancement, which planned the luncheon.











# **COMING HOME WEEKEND**

highlighted by gifts, friendship and fun



A single gift of nearly \$26,000 from Beta Omicron Alumni Chapter helped to cap a weekend of activities by Tennessee State University alumni to raise funds for scholarships to support students at their alma mater.

Thousands, including former and current students, friends and supporters, gathered April 15-16, 2016 at the William Jasper Hale Stadium, affectionately known as "The Hole," for the annual Blue and White football scrimmage as part of the weekend of activities. This was the third year for the Legends Coming Home Weekend.

Tony Wells, former president of the TSU National Alumni Association, said the weekend is a time for alumni to come back and engage with students.

"Homecoming is when alumni come back and interact with each other," Wells said. "But this is

an effort to come back in the spring and make sure we are engaging students and helping them with their networking. We don't want to wait until they are ready to graduate. We want to be there to help them understand the process before they leave."

More than 300 participated in the Big Blue Tiger 5K Run/Walk April 16 which kicked off the day on the main campus. Organizers say nearly 600 registered for the race although many did not plan to run.

The organization, "One Party, One Purpose," comprised of TSU alumni representing various Greek-letter organizations, also hosted an event during the weekend. The group has contributed more than \$20,000 to the TSU Foundation for scholarship support.



At most birthday celebrations, the guest of honor may expect all types of cards or gifts to commemorate the occasion. But Tennessee State University alumnus, Grant Winrow (1989) used his special day for a special cause — raising dollars for scholarships.

In lieu of personal gifts and presents, Winrow asked his nearly 300 guests to donate to The Hershey & Shirley M. Winrow Scholarship Fund — as not only a tribute in recognition of his milestone "50 Shades of Grant" birthday celebration, but also in honor of his parents to whom the fund is named. More than \$8,000 has been raised so far, and the first of two \$1,000 scholarships will be awarded in the fall 2016 semester.

"I simply wanted my 50th birthday to be purposeful," he said. "It was important for me to honor my parents, who were both alumni of the university and always stressed the importance of obtaining a college degree to me and my brothers."

Among the highlights of the birthday bash included a surprise performance by R&B platinum recording artist, Michel'le, who currently stars in the TV One reality show, *R&B Divas L.A.* TSU President Glenda Glover and TSU Foundation Board of Trustees Chairman Dwayne Tucker each generously donated \$1,000 to support the scholarship fund.

"I wanted to lead by example and hopefully inspire my classmates and friends to give back to the university that gave so much to us," Winrow said.

Since starting Carpenter Primary Healthcare, PLLC in February 2015, a family practice located at Methodist South Hospital Medical Office Complex in Memphis, Tennessee, the Carpenters have enjoyed a stellar year that held steadfast to the business mission of "providing excellent patient-centered preventive and primary health care."

The couple's business is focused on fostering good health and well-being in Memphis communities,

and in just a short time has amassed numerous accolades for the work they are doing. In April 2015, the company participated in the Memphis Black Expo as an exhibitor. A month later the company received the "New Outstanding Business" Benny Award from the Black Business Association of Memphis. That achievement was highlighted by yet another honor this past April with recognition as the 2016 Tennessee Minority Business of the Year by the U.S. Small Business Administration.

She holds a Master of Science in Nursing from the University of Tennessee Health Science Center at Memphis and a Doctor of Nursing Practice (DNP) from Union University. She has been recognized among the "Top 100 Nurses" in Shelby and Fayette County, and received a certificate by the Tennessee Nurses Association for "Outstanding Nursing Achievement." # Sabrina Goodwin Monday makes mark with Mary Kay

In 1983, Monday earned a bachelor's degree in Speech Communication and Theatre from TSU. After graduating, she went on to earn a master's degree in broadcast journalism from Boston University and spent time putting her journalism degree to work for *The Boston Globe* 

newspaper. But the entrepreneurial bug kept biting at her.

Eventually, she opened an accessories business selling hats, belts, jewelry and other items, while continuing to work full-time for the newspaper.

"I would have someone else run the business during the day and I came after my media job," Monday said. "I liked the feeling of self-

independence and self-reliance."

That infectious feeling only intensified after meeting Executive National Sales Director, Gloria Mayfield Banks, who one day approached her about working as a Mary Kay consultant. Although Monday declined the invitation for four months, she eventually said yes to the opportunity, which has now turned into a 27-year career.

She mixed her Mary Kay business with her accessories store, only selling the beauty products as a part-time venture. She soon began to notice the income pouring in from Mary Kay was outpacing the accessories business. In less

than two years, on a part-time basis, she grew her income to \$250,000 and earned the coveted Mary Kay Pink Cadillac. "The business works when you work it," she said. In 1992, she left *The Boston Globe* to focus on Mary Kay full-time.



"Mary Kay has allowed so many women to buy a house, quit a job or take care of an aging family member," Monday said. "Its biggest purpose is changing people's lives."

Building a business in the beauty industry has been a fruitful and fulfilling career for Monday. In addition to her army of sales directors in the United States, she has also established international teams in Brazil, Canada and Colombia. She has earned over \$2 million in commissions and was the No.1 sales director in the state of Oklahoma for several years. She is now one of the leading national sales directors in the company.

"There have been many highlights throughout my career, and it's afforded me the opportunity to be influential in many women's lives globally and to help them live better," she said, adding that she now has 2,000 women in her organization and has traveled to more than 30 countries.

"To change the world, you must see the world," she added.

In addition to her time with Mary Kay, she still manages to make time for her family and her beloved alma mater. She is married to Kenny Monday, an Olympic gold medalist who made history in 1988 as the first African-American Olympic champion in wrestling. He is a member of the

National Wrestling Hall of Fame, a world champ, five-time national champ and coach. They have three children.

She began serving on the TSU Women's Center Advisory Board at the urging of retired Honors Program director and former director of the Center, Dr. Sandra Holt. Monday continues to volunteer her time and donate resources to assist students.

"I love to create a place to be interactive with students and mentor them when they arrive on campus," Monday said. "To whom much is given, much is required. We have got to do our part. If everybody just does a little, we can accomplish a lot."

victories nationally and statewide, 24 high school All-Americans, and 22 college All-Americans in addition to Olympic medalists.





The 87-year-old criminal justice major was among hundreds of graduate students participating in TSU's May 6 spring commencement. Guth graduated with a 3.8 grade point average. When she

Guth has recorded more than 10 albums; some country, but mostly gospel. She eventually was inducted into the Atlanta Country Music Hall of Fame, and was named Entertainer of the Year by the Atlanta Society of Entertainers.

Even though her music career was thriving, Guth said education was still important to her. In 2003, she received her undergraduate degree from Georgia State at the age of 74. Now that she has her master's, she also plans to pursue a doctorate degree at TSU.

# Top NASA executive credits mentoring and TSU for 33 years of success

One of NASA's top African-American executives never even considered a career in engineering and science until a high school mentoring program opened his eyes to new possibilities.

Dr. Rickey J. Shyne joined the staff of the National Aeronautics and Space Administration's John H. Glenn Research Center at Lewis Field in Cleveland in 1984. He was appointed to senior executive service in 2005 and was appointed to his current role in 2014. Today, he is responsible for leading and managing Glenn's research and development

competencies in propulsion, communications, power, and materials and structures for extreme environments with a staff of more than 1,000 scientists, engineers and administrative staff in support of NASA's aeronautics and space missions.

As director of Research and Engineering, Shyne credits mentoring and Tennessee State University for preparing him for a career that now spans more than 33 years.

"I wanted to be a lawyer," Shyne said. "I had absolutely no plans to be an engineer. I grew up in

Dayton (Ohio) and I didn't get to see a lot of that."

Shyne said meeting an attorney during a high school mentoring program helped him to refocus his plans of practicing law, putting him on a new course.

"He told me to go into some area of specialization. 'If you want to be a tax lawyer, take up accounting or become a CPA...if you want to be a patent lawyer, study engineering or science."

During a time before Google, the public library provided a place for Shyne to research career opportunities, which ultimately



sparked his interest in mechanical engineering.

"I looked through a set of bound volumes that U.S. Department of Labor had published on careers," Shyne said. "During my research, I saw civil engineering, but I was not interested in building bridges. I saw electrical engineering, which did not move me. But then I saw careers for mechanical engineering and that was something that sounded pretty interesting to me."

Shyne eventually made his way to Tennessee State University, earning a Bachelor of Science in Mechanical Engineering in 1983. While a student, he involved himself in the American Society of Mechanical Engineers, the National Society of Black Engineers, the Ohio Club and joined Omega Psi Phi Fraternity, Incorporated.

"After high school, I made the decision to go to college and I was looking at schools in Ohio, but a good friend of the family, who had graduated high school a couple of years before me, swayed me into giving TSU a try," he said, adding that he found the TSU campus to be smaller, more intimate and family-oriented.

He also said retired Professor Yvonne "Y.Y." Clark, P.E., chair of the Department of Mechanical

# Reid paves way as first African-American to head as NASA Senior Executive

After spending three years in the military, Dr. Lonnie Reid decided that along with the discipline and training received from his military experience he also wanted to pursue additional education. The North Carolina native was certain that he wanted to attend a Historically Black College and University (HBCU), and that HBCU was Tennessee State University.

He arrived on campus making it as a "walk-on" football player and earning a four-year scholarship. The now 80-year-old mechanical engineer, said keeping up with football and the demands of his major, was "hard work," but he was fortunate to be surrounded with "likeminded people."

"Except for football, I hung out with engineers," said Reid, who also joined Alpha Phi Alpha Fraternity, Incorporated. "There are many things that are doable, you just have to have the right mindset and the right work ethic."

Reid earned a Bachelor of Science in Mechanical Engineering from TSU in 1961, then went on to the University of Toledo where he received a master's degree in mechanical engineering. Ultimately, he earned a doctorate in engineering science in 1990.

Over the years Reid built a successful career with the National Aeronautics and Space Administration becoming the first African-American in the history of the NASA Glenn Lewis Research Center to join the ranks of senior executive service. In 1993, he was elevated to chief of the Internal Fluid Mechanics Division.

"It demonstrated that there are engineers who come from everywhere," Reid said. "I had the most technical division in the laboratory; and we did very sophisticated experiments" which included studying the flow of air through aircraft engines by measuring temperature, velocity, and density of air inside engines as well as using computer simulations to predict engine performance and develop quieter and cleaner aircraft engines.

Reid currently operates AP Solutions, Inc., a Cleveland, Ohiobased firm providing engineering research support to the Glenn Research Center, and other select agencies and companies, in the area of gas turbine engine technology.

Recognized internationally for his expertise in compressor technology of aircraft engines, Reid's work and contributions have been acknowledged through numerous honors including being named Tennessee State University's Outstanding Mechanical Engineering Alumnae in 1985, receiving the NASA Exceptional Service Medal in 1989, and as an inductee into the Ohio Science, Technology and Industry Hall of Fame in 1993.



Engineering, was like a second mother away from home, encouraging responsibility, learning and exposure.

Shyne's introduction to NASA came through TSU as well, and the university's partnerships that helped students land internships, co-ops and jobs. Since joining NASA, Shyne has been a part of major research efforts, including developing the Orion Spacecraft, a replacement for the space shuttle, or testing hardware for spacecraft simulations.

"At NASA, we get to create history every day with the work we do," Shyne said. "Most of the work we do is on behalf of the American public. It has application to everyday life."

Other research efforts that have led to major societal benefits include technology and health care advancements providing doctors and other health care professionals, especially in underserved communities, more access to clinics for preventive care.

Dr. Lonnie Reid, also a TSU alumnus earning a mechanical engineering degree in 1961, hired Shyne early on and mentored him. When he decided to retire from NASA, Shyne became the second African-American to lead as chief of the Turbine Engine Group. Reid was the first.

"I met Rickey as a summer student at NASA before he graduated from TSU," Reid said. "During that time, for the most part, if students worked hard NASA promised them a job. He was not in my section, but he had a good grade point average. I eventually hired him and we developed a strong relationship. He was a high quality person."

Reid also encouraged Shyne to further his education and attend graduate school. Shyne heeded that advice and went on to earn a Master of Science in Mechanical Engineering and Doctor of Philosophy in Engineering Science, both from the University of Toledo in Ohio.

Along the way, Shyne has amassed some impressive accolades. He completed the prestigious Harvard University John F. Kennedy School of Government Senior Executive Fellows Program in Public Policy,

the Aspen Institute Executive Management Program, and the Pennsylvania State University Engineer/Scientist Management Executive Development Program.

He is a registered professional engineer in the state of Ohio, was inducted as a charter member of TSU's Alpha Delta Chapter of Pi Tau Sigma Mechanical **Engineering Honor Fraternity** and is the recipient of numerous honors including the 2014 Federal Professional Engineer of the Year Award, the 2013 Presidential Rank Award for Meritorious Service by President Barack Obama, and the 2008 U.S. Black Engineer of the Year Award for Career Achievement in Government, to name a few. Shyne also serves as a board member of the Cleveland **Engineering Society and Minds** Matter, a non-profit whose mission is to transform the lives of accomplished high school students from low-income families by broadening their dreams and preparing them for college success.


"You always have to take advantage of opportunities because you never know when they will present themselves again," Shyne said. "God had a plan for me and had I not been open to those possibilities, I never would have received these blessings. Everything we desire may not be what God desires for us."

Further, Shyne continues to give back to his alma mater by serving as a mentor, guest lecturer and identifying students for NASA internship opportunities.

"TSU gave me so much and this is my way of giving back just a portion of what I received," he said.

# McLendon elected into Naismith Memorial Basketball Hall of Fame

Basketball coaching legend John McLendon, who coached the Tennessee State University Men's Basketball team to three back-to-back NAIA National Championships in the late 1950s, has been elected to the Naismith Memorial Basketball Hall of Fame as a coach. He is part of the 10-member Class of 2016 that will be inducted into the Naismith Memorial Basketball Hall of Fame on Sept. 9 in Springfield, Massachusetts. McLendon had previously been enshrined to the Hall of Fame in 1979 as a contributor to the game.

McLendon served as the head coach of the TSU Men's Basketball program from 1954-1959, compiling a 144-20 overall record in five seasons. Utilizing the talent of future NBA All-Star Dick Barnett, McLendon guided the Tigers to NAIA National Championships in 1957, 1958 and 1959. His .878 winning percentage at TSU is the best in program history.

McLendon learned under the inventor of basketball, Dr. James Naismith, while a student at the University of Kansas. The court where the Tennessee State Men's and Women's Basketball teams play in the Howard C. Gentry Complex was dedicated as "McLendon Court" during the 1991-92 season.

McLendon was elected into the Tennessee State Athletics Hall of Fame in 1983, the National Collegiate Basketball Hall of Fame in 2007 and the Cleveland State Hall of Fame in 2007.

# **Former Tigerbelles** among **Olympians** honored at U.S. **Olympic Track** and Field Trials

Former Tennessee State University Tigerbelles Chandra Cheeseborough-Guice and Madeline Manning Mims were among Olympians honored during the U.S. Olympic Track and Field Trials in Eugene, Oregon.

The women participated in the opening ceremony at storied Hayward Field and joined other Olympians who were recognized for their achievements throughout the trials July 1-10, 2016.

"It's exciting," said Cheeseborough-Guice, director of TSU's track and field program. "It's was like a reunion."

Mims said she was looking forward to reconnecting with other Olympians.

"We're all out there doing our thing and we're in different places, so we don't get a chance to see each other," Mims said. "This was a great opportunity for us to come back together, and find out what's going on, and watch the young ones come in."

Cheeseborough-Guice emerged on the scene in 1975 at age 16, where she won a gold medal in the 200-meter dash in the Pan American Games. She went on to be named to three United States Olympic teams. In 1984, at the Los Angeles games, she made Olympic history by running a leg on two gold-medal relay teams and was the silver medalist in the 400 meters.

Between 1967 and 1981, Mims won 10 national titles and set a number of American records. She participated in the 1968, 1972 and 1976 Olympics. At the 1968 games, she was awarded a gold medal in the 800-meter race, the only American woman to win the event. In 1972, she won a silver medal in the 4 x 400 meters relay. Mims founded the U.S. Council for Sports Chaplaincy and the 2016 Rio Summer Olympics will be her eighth as a Team USA chaplain.

Dwight Lewis, who is co-authoring a book about TSU's famed Tigerbelles, said it's only fitting that Cheeseborough-Guice and Mims should be recognized during the trials because they were part of a team that "paved the way for other women in sports."

The Tigerbelles got the attention of the world in 1956 when TSU (Tennessee A&I at the time), led by legendary track and field Coach Ed Temple, sent six members to the Olympics in Australia. The Tigerbelles returned to the 1960 Olympics in Rome and made history when Wilma Rudolph won three gold medals, making her a household name.

The Tigerbelles won a total of 23 Olympic medals. Lewis said what was also impressive about members of the team is that they also excelled outside track and field.

"Not only did they perform well in track and field, but ... they got their degrees," he said.

Temple said Cheeseborough-Guice and Mims, as well as all his Tigerbelles, are inspirations and deserve all the recognition they continue to get.

"They are an inspiration to everybody," Temple said. "It just shows what can be done. Where there's a will, there's a way."

# Mamie Rallins, 74

Former Tigerbelle, U.S. Olympian Class of 1976

Former Tennessee State University Tigerbelle and U.S. Olympian Mamie Rallins, 74, passed away May 16 following a car accident in Ohio.

Rallins, who graduated from TSU in 1976, ran for legendary TSU track and field coach Ed Temple. She competed for the United States in the hurdles during the 1968 Olympics in Mexico City as well as the 1972 Olympics in Munich.

The Chicago native went on to serve as head coach of the track and field/cross country programs at Ohio State University, Hampton University and Chicago State University. She was the first African-American woman to coach at Ohio State and also served as an assistant athletic director for three years.

Helping to start the women's track and field program at Ohio State, she coached 60 Big Ten champions, 24 All-Americans and one Olympian during her 18-year career in Columbus.

On the national and international level, Rallins was the head coach of the U.S. Indoor World Championship team in 1987 and was an assistant coach for the U.S. Olympic Team in 1996. At the 2000 Olympic Games in Sydney, Australia, Rallins worked as the head manager for the USA women's track and field team.

# Oklahoma's first black state senator dies at 86

E. Melvin Porter, Oklahoma's first black state senator, died Tuesday, July 26, 2016, died following a lengthy illness.

He was 86.

Born in Okmulgee in 1930, Porter was a member of the first class to include blacks at Vanderbilt University Law School. He went on to become president of the Oklahoma City branch of the National Association for the Advancement of Colored People in 1961.

Porter participated in sitins and boycotts with civil

rights leader Clara Luper, and also provided legal services for the organization.

Porter unsuccessfully ran for the Oklahoma House of Representatives as a Republican in 1962. As a Democrat, he was elected to the state senate in 1964.

He held the office for 22 years.

In office, Porter introduced the state's Anti-Discrimination Act, Oklahoma's equivalent of the federal Civil Rights Act of 1964.

Porter's political career came to an end in 1986, when he lost his seat to Vicki Miles-LaGrange.

He was appointed an Oklahoma County commissioner in January 1993, but resigned in July 1994 amid controversy.

Last year, on the 50th anniversary of his first election to office, Porter was honored with a resolution put forth in the Oklahoma Senate.

Daughter-in-law LaTonya Porter said she was surprised at how much her father-in-law had influenced Oklahoma.

"It was just incredible being in his presence. He was one of the funniest men I've ever encountered. He had stories that were incredible. He was just so funny, and I don't think people realized it.

"He loved to play dominoes. He was a very aggressive domino player. He talked a lot of noise. People didn't see that side of him. To me, he was just Eddie," she said.

# Norman K. Spencer, 80

Longtime educator and retired president of the former Berean Institute, Dr. Norman K. Spencer, 80, passed away January 4, 2016 of complications from cancer.

Spencer had a lengthy career with the School District of Philadelphia prior to being appointed president of Berean Institute. He served in numerous capacities up until his retirement from the school district in 1993. As president of Berean Institute, he expanded curriculum, initiated several annual programs, and helped to transform the school into a 21st century postsecondary associate degree granting institution. He retired from the post in 2006.

As a Tennessee State University student, he was a member of the History, Geography and Spanish Honor Societies, as well as Kappa Alpha Psi Fraternity, Incorporated, in which he served as vice president of the Alpha Theta Chapter and was the first undergraduate member of the fraternity's Grand Board of Directors.
