Childhood Hearing Loss Grant Curriculum

In collaboration with Vanderbilt University's
Department of Hearing & Speech Sciences

This program is funded by a U.S. Department of Education training grant entitled "High-Quality Personnel Preparation to Serve Infants and Young Children with Hearing Loss."

Students participating in the Childhood Hearing Loss Specialty Track must complete the following additional coursework and activities:

- **4 additional courses (7 hours)**
- **3-week Maymester (2 hours):** This training includes a 3-week immersion program at a site that specializes in childhood hearing loss.
- **Extended Clinical Practicum:** Trainees will receive placements in the VUMC preschool for children with hearing loss – the Mama Lere Hearing School, and the newborn nurseries at Vanderbilt University Medical Center, among others. Placements at these sites will include hands-on experience in delivering hearing loss-specific services.
- **2 half-day interdisciplinary seminars offered during one of the years in training. These are held on weekends.**
- **50 volunteer hours:** This time is spent with our pediatric hearing loss programs and can be spread across the first year of the program.
- **Hearing Loss Journal Club:** Trainees will participate in a monthly journal club devoted to research-to-practice guided readings and discussions in the area of childhood hearing loss.

OTHER PROGRAM OPPORTUNITIES:

Travel Award: Trainees will receive funding to attend the Early Hearing Detection and Intervention (EHDI) Annual Meeting.

Stipend: \$13,000 per academic year

Interdisciplinary approach to training: TSU students will train with Vanderbilt Department of Hearing and Speech Sciences program graduate students in fields of speech-language pathology, audiology, and deaf education.
