
- 1. Go to the CITI website: https://about.citiprogram.org/

3. Next click on "Select Your Organization Affiliation"






4. Start typing Tennessee State University. A dropdown list will appear. Select Tennessee State University from the list.





5. Check both boxes.


• Then click on **Create a CITI Program account**
